Financial Assistance

Employment Related Day Care is a child care financial assistance program. If a parent/family meets the household and general income requirements, they may be eligible for this assistance. Contact us to learn more.

The Learning Circle

The Learning Circle (TLC) is a literacy-based training program that provides training in the providers environment. The TLC program is designed to stimulate the love of reading in children of all ages. TLC mobile trainers model stimulating story times and related activities with the children in each provider's care.
