Offers services to formerly homeless families and individuals facing housing barriers.

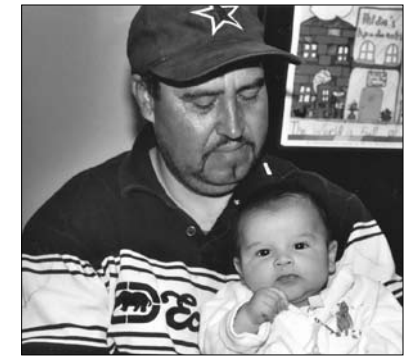
